2 Overview

2.1 About this guide

The id3 License Manager is a Windows application that helps you manage your license files. Before you can use id3 Software Development Kits (SDKs), you must have the correct license installed.

The purpose of this guide is to describe the use of id3 License Manager 5.7.2 and how to activate a license.

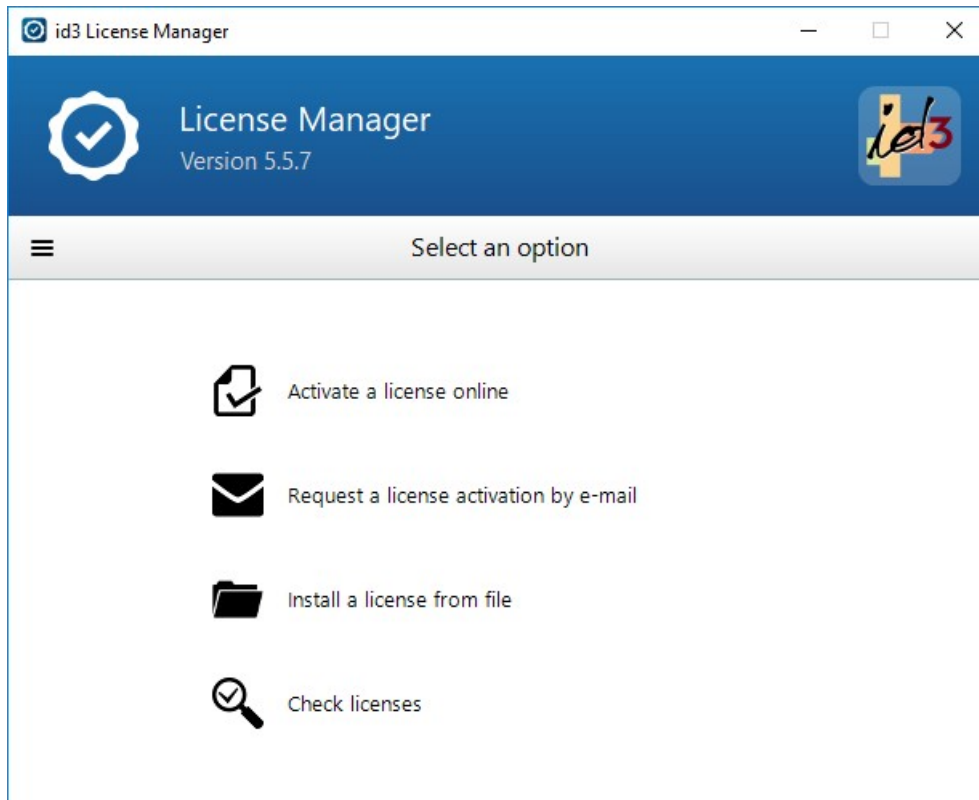


Figure 1: License Manager - Main Screen

2.2 System requirements

- Microsoft Windows 7, 8 or 10,
- An active Internet connection

2.3 Hardware IDs

A license is bound to either a uniquely identified computer or a standard USB key. A license is associated to either a computer or a flash drive. It contains a hardware ID based on:

- Host name
- Volume name
- MAC address
- Hard-drive disk (on Unix system only sda, sdb, sdc, vda, vdb, vdc)
- Serial number of a USB key

Any change on one of these items may invalidate existing licenses on the computer. A mobile license moved from a device to another will not be valid anymore.

2.4 License types

Trial license

A trial license grants access to a software for a limited period of time (generally 30 to 60 days). The trial license locks on a uniquely identified computer.

Developer license

A developer license is required to develop an application based on id3 SDK.

Runtime license

A runtime license is required to deploy an application based on id3 SDK.

3 Activating a license online

On the main screen, select the 'Activate license online' option and press on the Next button.

3.1 Login / enter serial

Fill the window with your account information:




Figure 2: Account information

You can also enter the serial number (or activation key) in the appropriate field. You can also copy and paste the activation key.

When the field is filled correctly, you can press on the Next button.

NOTE – If the serial number does not exist or if there is no available license for the product binded to the serial number, an error is displayed.

3.2 Select the product to activate

Only the products with available licenses are displayed. If the product you want to activate does not appear in this window, please contact the sales support.

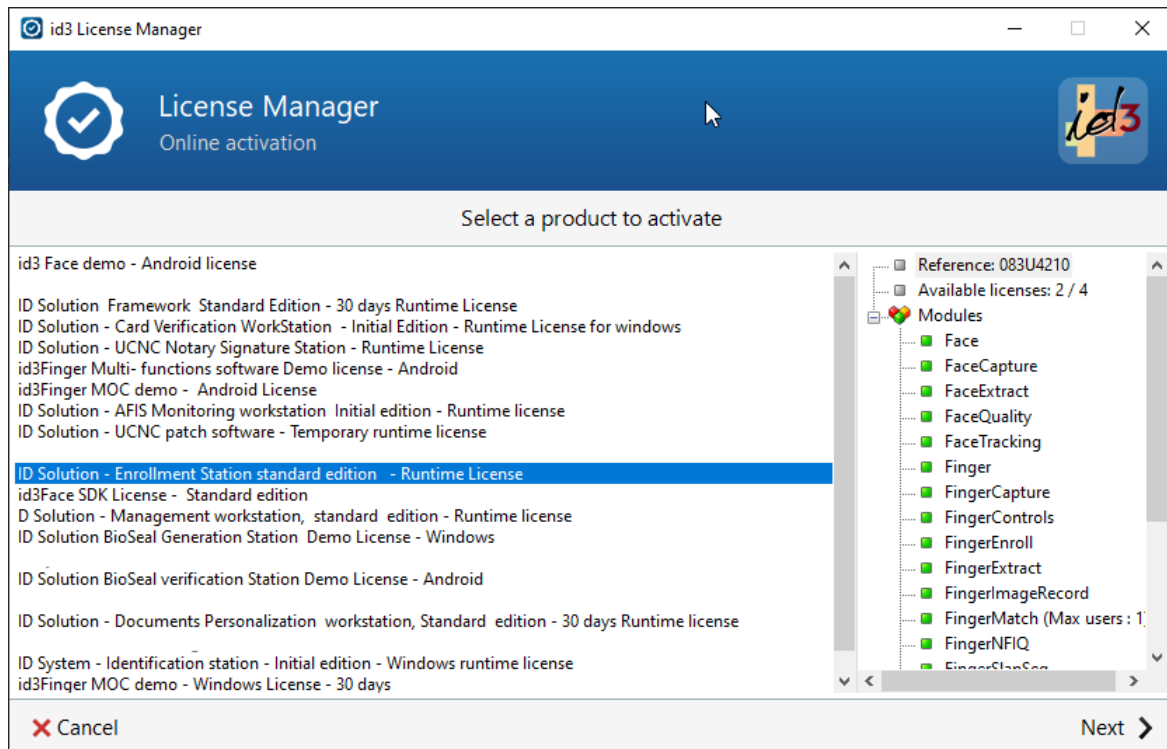


Figure 3: Product selection

Click on **Next**.

3.3 Select the license type

The license is locked to either a uniquely identified computer (fixed license) or an external USB drive (mobile license). The next screen allows you to choose between the two options.

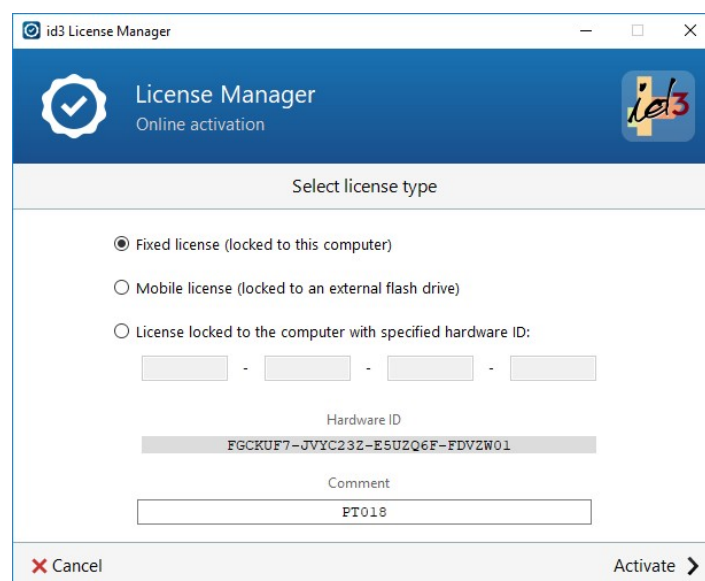


Figure 4: License Activation - License Type

NOTE – You can enter a short description of the target computer in the 'Comment' field.

When you are ready to continue, press **Activate**. The registration wizard will send the activation data to our license activation server.

Requirements

The machine on which you are activating the product must be able to send outgoing data on port 80 and receive the associated response.

- If you have a personal firewall running on your machine, make sure it will allow this traffic
- If you are accessing the Internet through a corporate network, make sure the corporate firewall will allow this traffic.

3.4 Confirm activation

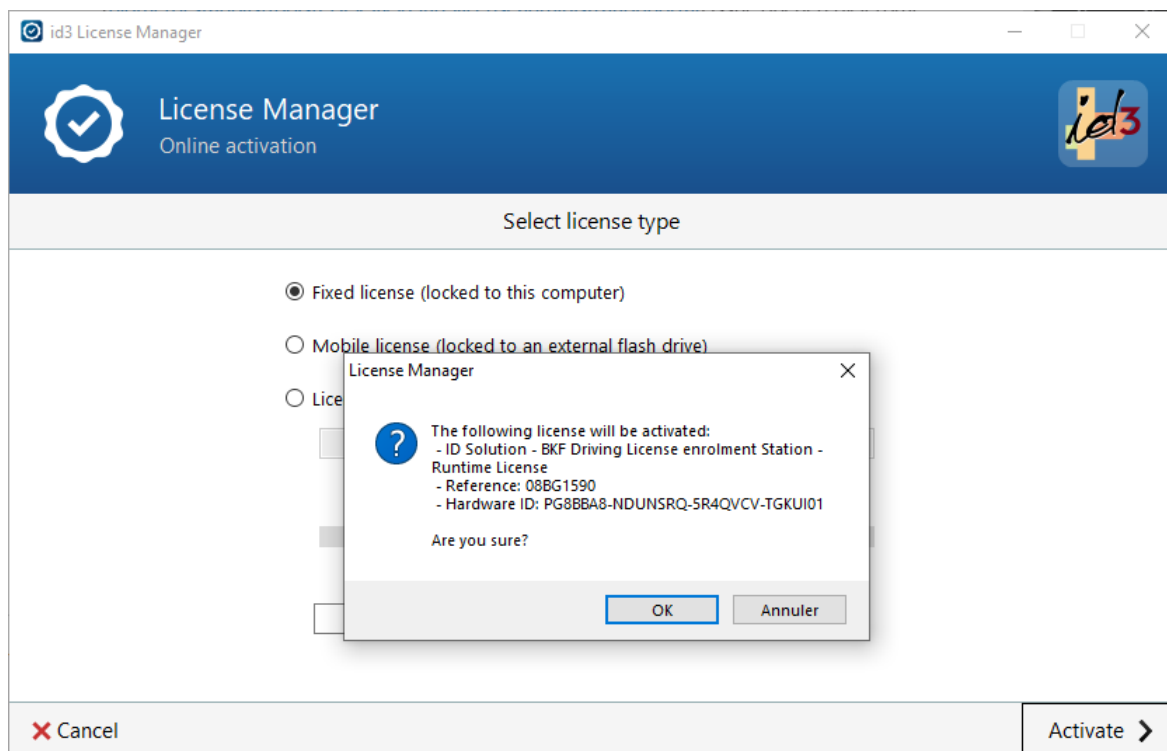


Figure 5: Activation confirmation

Click **OK**.

At this point, the license has been successfully activated and installed on the computer.

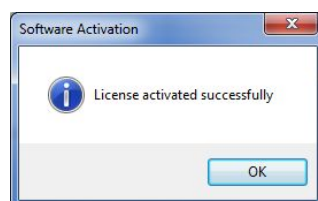


Figure 6: License Activation - Activation Status

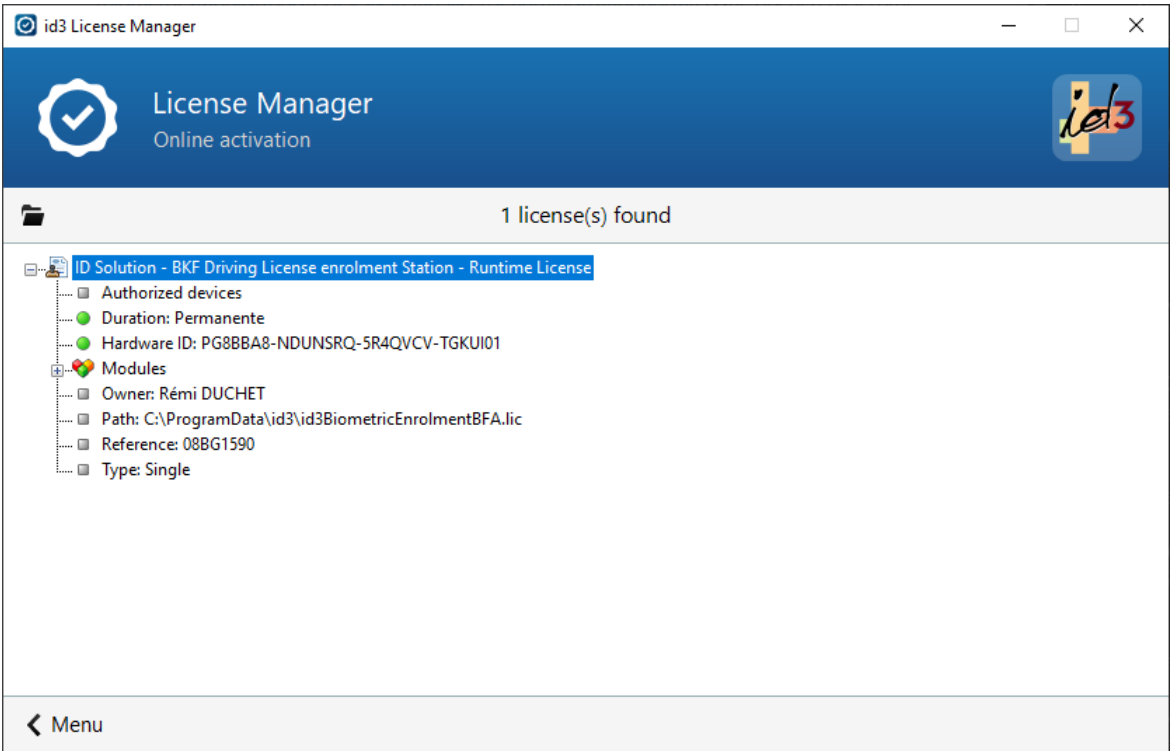



Figure 7: Activated license

4 Activating a license by e-mail

If you do not have an account nor an activation, but you need to activate an email (for instance for evaluation purposes), select *Request a license activation by e-mail*

4.1 Select the license type


For a license associated to this computer, select *Fixed license*.

For a license associated to a mobile device, select *Mobile license*.





Click on *Next*.

4.2 Fill the form

Fill the form by indicating your name, your email and some details about the requested license: at least the name of the product.

Click on *Apply by email*. An Internet connection is required to sent the e-mail.

5 Installing a License File

On the machine **where the license has to be installed**, launch the License Manager and select *Install a license from file*. Connect the flash drive where the license has been previously saved on.

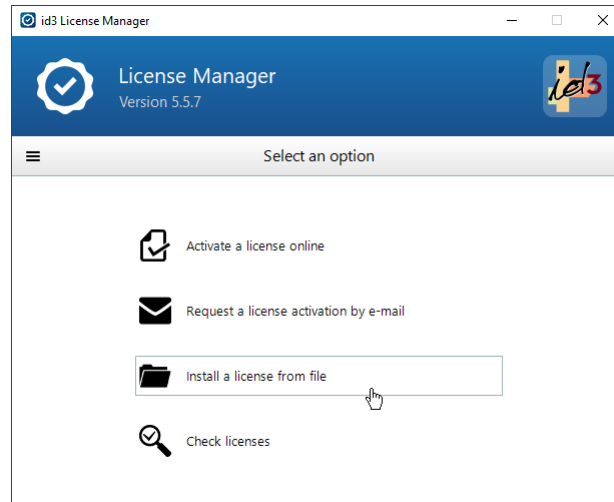


Figure 11: License installation selection

Select the license file previously activated. It is automatically renamed and copied in the right directory. The installed license can be visualized by selectionning *Check licenses* on the License Manager main screen.

6 Checking licenses

From the main screen, select the 'Check licenses' option. The following screen appears:

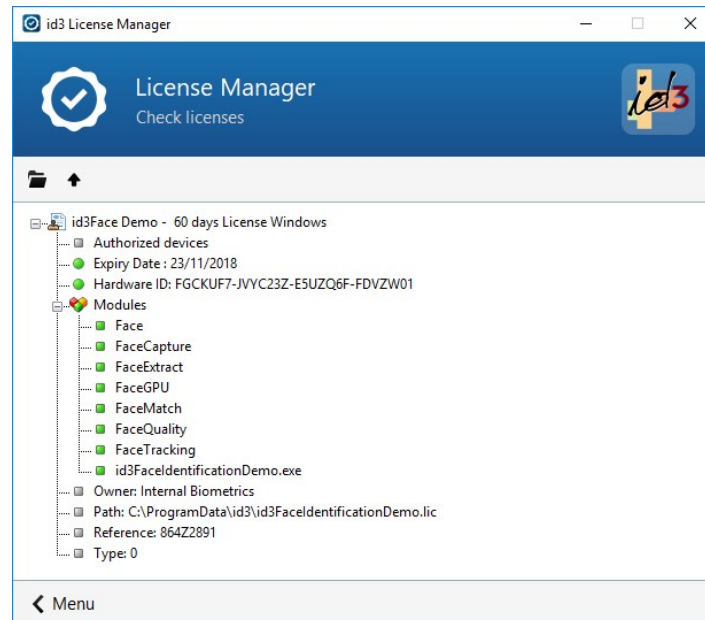


Figure 12: License Manager - Check License

NOTE – By default, the license file is searched in the following paths, in that order:

- Directory of the application, next to the main library file
- Root directory of a USB-stick
- User's private application data folder (C:\Users\\AppData\Roaming\id3)
- System-wide application data folder (C:\ProgramData\id3)



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
